### **House Construction**

#### Stage 1 (A, L) - 8 homes

The first six homes were completed in late-2024. These are the 1-bed homes facing Jopp St. In February a further two households moved into the 2 and 3-bedroom homes, also facing Jopp St.

#### Stage 1 (B) - 7 homes

Over Easter seven households moved into their new homes - a mixture of 2 and 3-bed. These properties are located on Pātiki Loop, nearest the river.

#### Stage 2 (C, D, E) - 18 homes

Construction is well underway on Stage 2. These homes will be ready for staged occupancy from mid-2025 through to late-2025.

Stage 3 - construction scheduled to commence May 2025.

Construction hours for all work involving noise remains Mon-Fri 7:00 - 18:00.

# **Arrow River Reserve**

You may have noticed a bit of digger action taking place on the river reserve, just below Tewa Banks. In partnership with the Queenstown Lakes District Council, we're stoked to have at last cleared this overgrown area.

We've removed all the weeds, broom and scrub – leaving behind just the trees. The site has now been handed back to QLDC to replant in an effort to improve and support the natural environment. And of course, to provide a public green space.

Our vision is to make it accessible and useable for the wider public, in the same way as Arrowtown's existing river reserve areas. Eventually it will be a fantastic green space and open up fully down to the river trail.
