Policy for Social (Public) Housing Rental Programme Eligibility Criteria and Parameters – 1.5

October 2020 Updated March 2023, March 2024

Background:

The primary goal of the Social Housing Rental ("SHR") programme is to provide affordable, secure tenure in decent quality homes to low-income households subsidised by the Government's Income Related Rent Subsidy (IRRS). This policy is also applicable to households who qualify for QLCHT's Senior Housing Eligibility Criteria policy 1.3.

<u>Policy</u>

Eligibility criteria:

- 1. In order to qualify for the SHR programme, households must also be on the Government's Social Housing register.
- 2. The maximum household income for the SHR programme is determined by the Ministry of Social Development (MSD).
- 3. The property must be used exclusively as the household's primary residence, i.e. it is not to be used as a second home or holiday house.
- 4. Households cannot vacate the property for more than four weeks of the year without QLCHT permission.
- 5. Applicants cannot own, or have a financial interest in, any other property.
- 6. Within each household at least one member is a New Zealand resident or citizen.

Setting of rent

7. SHR rents will be set by the MSD alone.

Programme parameters:

- 8. Households which qualify for Senior Housing will sign up to QLCHT's *Social Housing Rental* (*Senior*) *Residential Tenancy Agreement* with an indefinite lease.
- 9. All other SHR tenants will sign up to QLCHT's *Social Housing Rental Residential Tenancy Agreement* with a periodic lease.

- 10. All SHR households will be subject to QLCHT's Housing Management Policies as detailed in QLCHT policy 9.3.
- 11. SHR tenants will be required to pay a bond equating to 4 weeks Income Related Rent (IRR).
- 12. Where demand exceeds supply for SHR properties, households will be prioritised on a needs basis, in line with QLCHT's Allocation of QLCHT Properties Policy (9.15).
- 13. Any changes to the Residential Tenancy Act may override the parameters and rules established within this policy.
