

Secure Home Financial Declaration and Acknowledgement

Entering into the Secure Home programme home is an exciting milestone but it also represents one of the biggest commitments you are likely to make.

The Queenstown Lakes Community Housing Trust (QLCHT) wants you to be confident that you understand the obligations you are taking on, and that in order to do so you have sought independent advice from an appropriately qualified and/or experienced person in the likes of finance and budgeting regarding your agreement with us and your mortgage arrangements. Further, QLCHT asks that you confirm that your legal representative has explained how the Secure Home programme operates in detail.

I, «**fullname1**» as applicant for the QLCHT Secure Home Programme declare and acknowledge:

1. That as part of the application process I have taken sufficient and adequate advice so as to ensure:
 - a. That I know and have established that I can without undue hardship meet all household and other related financial obligations
 - b. That reasonably unforeseen circumstances that could detrimentally affect my ability to meet such financial obligations have been considered and provided for.
 - c. That I have made enquiries and have satisfied myself that the finance I have arranged is competitive in the market place.
 - d. That I have undertaken adequate and appropriate financial due diligence so as to ensure that I have established that I will be able to meet the financial obligations I will assume under the QLCHT Secure Home Agreement.
2. That I have had every opportunity to take all or any other advice I may think appropriate and that I am not proceeding based on any representation or otherwise made by any QLCHT trustee, officer or agent.
3. That I have had explained to me by an independent solicitor the effect and implications of the QLCHT Secure Home Programme, the Secure Home Agreement and the Secure Home Mortgagee Deed, and record that I understand the same.
4. That under no circumstances in respect to the QLCHT Secure Home Programme shall I commence, pursue or be a party to any claim against QLCHT in respect to any actions of QLCHT made in good faith.
5. QLCHT shall not be liable for any costs, claims or damages arising out of their administration of the Secure Home Programme or the applicants decision to enter it whether in contract, negligence, tort or otherwise.
